



Provide first aid in an ESI environment – UETTDRRF10

Module purpose	This unit provides the learner with the knowledge, skills and competencies to provide first aid in an Electrical Supply Industry (ESI) environment. It includes the recognition and provision of an initial response where first aid is required in emergency situations by providing essential first aid using basic life support measures according to established workplace first aid policies and procedures.
For whom	All personnel who are required to work in the vicinity of live electrical apparatus.
Prerequisites	HLTAID009 – Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
Summary of content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safety assessment at the scene - identify physical hazards and risks• Minimising risk• Assessing the situation and deciding of actions required• Assessing vital signs• Summoning medical assistance• Providing first aid to stabilise victim<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Managing the unconscious patient○ Controlling external bleeding○ Shock○ Burns – electrical / chemical○ Eye injuries○ Head injuries○ Anaphylaxis○ Sprains and strains○ Bites and stings• Use available first aid equipment as appropriate• Recording and reporting• Personal hygiene techniques
Assessment	Written and practical assessment demonstrating the ability to assess, manage and care for a victim in a simulated scenario.
Planned duration	Initial - 4 hours - for group of ten to fifteen learners Refresher – 1.5 – 2 hours
Frequency	Annual Assessment, or as industry requirements change.
