



## Perform pole top rescue - UETDRRF003

<b>Module purpose</b>	This unit provides the learner with the knowledge, skills and competencies to perform a Pole Top Rescue. (PTR)
<b>For whom</b>	All personnel required to work aloft, or who are required to assist a person working aloft.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	HLTAID009 – Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
<b>Summary of content</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Principles of PTR</li><li>• Content and inspection of PTR kits</li><li>• Field workers handbook</li><li>• Rescue procedure</li><li>• Variation<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contact with LV</li><li>• Contact with HV</li></ul></li><li>• Site security and incident reporting</li></ul>
<b>Assessment</b>	Written and practical assessment demonstrating the ability to rescue a victim from the head of a ladder erected against a pole.
<b>Planned duration</b>	Training session: Initial: 4 hours Refresher: 1-1.5 hours Assessment: 10 minutes per participant. Maximum of 8 participants
<b>Frequency</b>	Annual Assessment / Refresher Training.
