



## HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

<b>Module purpose</b>	This unit provides the learner with the knowledge, skills and competencies to perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.
<b>For whom</b>	All personnel who are required to work in the vicinity of live electrical apparatus and those who desire the ability to perform CPR.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	Nil
<b>Summary of content</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Duty of care</li><li>• Safety assessment at the scene and relevant workplace hazards</li><li>• Minimising risk</li><li>• Assessing vital signs of casualty</li><li>• Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (C.P.R)</li><li>• Managing the unconscious patient</li><li>• Recording and reporting</li><li>• Summoning medical assistance</li><li>• Infection control principles and procedures</li><li>• Understanding the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)</li></ul>
<b>Assessment</b>	The learning outcomes will be assessed using the appropriate "Practical Assessment Sheet".
<b>Planned duration</b>	Initial - 4 hours - for group of ten to fifteen learners Refresher – 1.5 - 2 hours
<b>Frequency</b>	Annual Assessment, or as industry requirements change.
